Immunizations



Preventive vaccines are offered for travel, adult, and childhood diseases. We can bill most insurances. For patients without insurance, we have a sliding scale fee for most vaccines. Please bring proof of income for the sliding fee scale. Please see our website for a current list of vaccines, administration costs, and participating insurance companies. TB Testing

TB Tests are available by appointment on Monday through Wednesday, with return to clinic 48–72 hours later for reading. We can bill some insurances.

Sexually Transmitted Disease Testing

Confidential testing for chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, and HIV. Free HIV testing offered in June and December. Please call for an appointment. No insurance necessary.

Blood Pressure

Clinic operates Monday through Friday. 8:30 am to 11:30 am and 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. (No fee)



Pregnancy Testing

Pregnancy Testing is offered Monday through Friday. Please call for additional information and to schedule an appointment.

Baby Your Baby

Those who already meet the income guidelines for Medicaid, are also able to qualify for the Baby Your Baby program, which helps moms prepare for a healthy pregnancy with the help of one of our nurses. Call our front desk and make an appointment.



Targeted Case Management

Home visits by a registered nurse serving children age 0–4. Assessment may include education on available resources and developmental screening.

Prenatal to 5 Home Visitation Program

Free developmental screenings performed by a registered nurse for premature infants. Please call for more information or to speak with a home visitation nurse.

WIC (Women, Infants & Children)

WIC is a supplemental food and nutrition program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). Pregnant women, new mothers, and young children may be provided healthy foods, nutrition counseling, and breastfeeding support. Eligibility is determined by family size and household gross income. If you are pregnant, your unborn child is considered a member of your family. To qualify you must:

- Live in Weber or Morgan County
- Be pregnant, breastfeeding, or just had a baby or have an infant or child under 5 years of age
- Need WIC foods to be healthy
- Meet income guidelines or be receiving Medicaid or food stamps.

Birth Certificates

Available for all Utah births from 1905–present. Birth records over 100 years may be available at the Utah State Archives 801-531-3848.

Death Certificates

Available for all Utah deaths from 1905–present. Death records over 50 years may be available at the Utah State Archives 801-531-3848.

Divorce Certificates

Available for all Utah divorces from 1978–2010.

Marriage Certificates

Available for all Utah marriages except Weber County from 1978–2010; Weber County records obtained at Weber County Clerk Auditor Office, 2380 Washington Blvd, Ogden UT 84401. 801-399-8400

Food Handlers Testing

The required training is 75 minutes, after which the exam will be administered. The cost for the training and permit is \$25. Picture I.D IS REQUIRED. You must register to ensure a seat in the class. You can register online at WeberMorganHealth.gov or you can call 801-399-7160 and someone will assist you. Classes are offered on Thursday as follows:

- 1st Thursday of the month at 9am
- 3rd Thursday of the month at 3pm
- **Spanish:** 3rd Wednesday of the month at 2pm

Morgan County residents can attend classes in Ogden or call 801-399-7160 to register for a class taught at our Morgan County office on the second Tuesday of each month.
