**Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) Presentation**

Joy Harris from PHAB highlighted the benefits of accreditation, including improved quality improvement, employee training, and community health equity. Key metrics: 100% reported stimulation of quality improvement, 93% improved employee training, and 80% applied equity to internal policies. Challenges include limited staff time, staff turnover, and leadership changes. The annual cost for Category 2 departments is \$8,400. The meeting also addressed the feasibility of choosing pathways over accreditation, noting limited data due to the newness of the pathways program. Dr. Schussman asked about return on investment for increased public trust and credibility that may come with accreditation. PHAB provides numerous public information materials including press releases to highlight the department once accredited. Angela Choberka asks for follow-up statistics about LHD retention rates for re-accreditation. Staff will find those numbers and report back.

**Dr. Gochmour Presentation****Information Only**

Dr. Gregory Gouchnor introduces himself and outlines his contractual role with the health department, which includes authorizing standing orders and guiding shared clinical decision-making. He discusses various public health programs he supports, including cancer screening, tuberculosis care, immigration health checkups, and infectious disease monitoring, management, and treatment.
