## Our purpose:

The Weber-Morgan Health Department offers home visitation services designed to support the health and development of children and families. Visiting nurses provide guidance, education, and connections to community resources.

## Telehealth or In-Person

Our public health nurses are available to you in your home or on the phone to coordinate health services and community resources to help your family have a healthy beginning. Services available from early pregnancy up to age 9.



## Link to Other Services

A care coordinator acts as centralized access point. The care coordinator links children and their families to internal, external, and community based services and programs.
